



TEP (Teenage Empowerment Programme) & Youth Clubs

It became evident that we needed to be proactive and assist in the prevention of HIV/AIDS and teenage pregnancies. Our TEP team works in several high schools in and around Amaoti giving Christian based life skills lessons and supporting teenagers. Currently 600 teenagers are impacted by this programme. On Friday afternoons over 300 children and teenagers attend our Youth Club. They are taught biblical principles, and work in groups to discuss life issues. Our focus is on developing skills and talents in young people.



Children & Family Support Project

The vision is that every orphan and child at risk will be placed in a godly family and that each child and family will become healthy and functional. We are committed to seeing these children thrive. This project works with the following groups; abused and raped children, orphans, child-headed households and children with behavioural problems. Our staff members visit homes, support children and caregivers and liaise with schools. **Our vision for the future is to build transition and foster homes to ensure that the evergrowing number of orphans and vulnerable children from Amaoti have a safe place to live.** At present vulnerable children are taken in by staff and volunteers from the community and are supported by the project.



Sports Development Project

Young people in the Amaoti community desperately need positive influences. Sports, and particularly soccer for the men, are a way of bringing people from the community together within a positive and sporting environment. Through our Sports Development Project we focus on building team spirit, team work, good values and healthy competition. We have formed a league for several age groups and our project manager and volunteers work with the coaches, team managers and players to bring about transformation in their lives.



Skills & Business Development

Although our focus is on children and youth, we don't forget the adults. A holistic approach to uplift a family is essential. Adults who were unable to finish their schooling have been empowered by our ABET English literacy programme and unemployed women are taught sewing and beading. We also support and mentor several businesses in Amaoti, among them a block plant, food café, car wash and laundry. Creating jobs and income generation is an important key to a successful future for Amaoti.
